Concordia University helps MOW clients

Concordia University
Wisconsin and Fresh Meals
On Wheels of Sheboygan
County have partnered to
help vulnerable seniors
remain in the place where
they feel most secure and
happy, and statistically have
the best health outcomes—
their homes.

Fresh Meals On Wheels provides fresh, medically-tailored meals and daily wellness checks to over 300 Sheboygan County seniors. Thanks to our collaboration with Concordia, those clients are being offered the opportunity to participate in an assessment program aimed at reducing fall risks and other factors that could impact their ability to live independently in their homes. The

program is voluntary, and Concordia is offering it free of charge.

When Meals On Wheels client Lorraine H. was asked to be part of the assessment program, she was excited to participate.

"I have grandchildren who went to school at Concordia, so I thought it was kind of nice that they called me," she said.

Fresh Meals On Wheels representatives and health care professionals from the Concordia faculty visited Lorraine to perform a home safety check, review her supplements and medications, and evaluate her physical, mental and emotional health. They returned for a third visit to present their recommendations,

which included using double-sided tape to secure loose rugs, and reviewing the need for certain supplements with her doctor.

"I found the pharmacist most helpful. I had time to talk about everything I was taking, and I could go to the cupboard and see a supplement I might have forgotten to mention to my doctor," she said.

At first Lorraine was concerned that having a group of strangers asking so many questions might be intimidating.

"I thought I might not want them to know all of this about me, but I felt very comfortable with them. They were so easy to talk to," she said. "I would recommend it to anyone."

Last April, the Sargento marketing team spent a day at Meals On Wheels doing spring clean-up in the gardens and orchard and helping in the kitchen.

"We were really inspired, not just by the work Meals On Wheels is doing, but by the thoughtfulness that goes into every last detail," said Christopher McCarthy, Sargento's director of integrated marketing communications.

Meals On Wheels serves just a fraction of the people in the county who could benefit from fresh, nutritious meals and daily wellness checks. Based on their experience at Meals On Wheels and Sargento's culture of community outreach, a group from the marketing team offered to help get the Meals On Wheels story out in the community.

McCarthy and fellow Sargento team members Ryan Hemsing, Cami Schenck, Heidi Haack, James Grunewald, Gina Pethan, Stephanie Meyer and Sherri Dutter started with the basics, such as helping refine our brand identity and branding guidelines Phase 2 is increasing awareness. To that end, the Sargento team suggested producing a series of short online videos.

"Their guidance has been invaluable. Their intention is to show us how to plan, set-up, shoot and edit the videos the first time, be there to guide us through the process the second time, and be available for advice if we hit a snag after that," said Meals On Wheels' Associate Executive Director Allison Thompson. "We can't thank them enough for all the time they have put in to help Meals On Wheels."

In addition to the videos, the Sargento team will be helping design a sample box Meals On Wheels can use to introduce health care professionals, caregivers and others to our fresh, tasty medically-tailored meals.

"If the ideas and tools we've shared can help Meals On Wheels recruit more clients, generate more donations, or inspire more people to volunteer, then we've accomplished much more than our goal," McCarthy said.

A sure hit for vegetarian night!

Jane's Three Bean Chili

Ingredients:

1 Tbs olive oil 1 onion, chopped

2 Tbs chili powder

2 Tbs cumin 1 can chili beans

1 can black beans

3-1/2 cups water

1-2 chopped peppers 3 cloves minced garlic

1 tsp oregano

12 oz beer

1 can garbanzo beans

28 oz crushed tomatoes Pepper to taste

Smoked paprika to taste

Heat oil in Dutch oven. Add onion and cook for 5 minutes, until translucent.

Add peppers and cook for 3 more minutes.

Add garlic, chili powder, cumin and oregano and cook for 2 minutes, until brown and fragrant.

Add beer and scrape up any bits stuck to the pot. Boil until reduced by half.

Add tomatoes, beans and water. Boil for one minute and then reduce heat.

Cover and simmer for 2-3 hours, stirring occasionally.

Add smoked paprika and pepper, and more water, if needed. Enjoy!
