Meals On Wheels has purchased the Rex Building and will renovate it to house a kitchen, a fresh produce processing center, and business offices. This is a unique project that will make waves nationally within our professional organization.

Local farmers, growers, and producers will be invited to donate fresh, local foods to the program and have them incorporated into our meals. The benefits of this new organization are many; using locally donated foods will allow us to control costs and increase the

nutritional value of our meals; having the business office next to the kitchen will increase program efficiency responding to clients needs, which is our priority, will be immediate.

To accomplish this renovation we are working with a talented team from Abacus Architects, Lean Kitchen Solutions and Jos. Schmitt Construction.
