The proposed federal budget cuts:

How will they impact Meals On Wheels of Sheboygan County?

Meals on Wheels funding has been a hot topic since President Trump released his proposed budget cuts on March 16. We have heard from a number of volunteers, clients and community members concerned about what those cuts would mean for Meals On Wheels of Sheboygan County, Inc. We would like to share information to help everyone better understand the situation.

Financial Impact

Meals On Wheels of Sheboygan County is supported by the kind donations of local businesses, organizations and individuals. All donations stay in Sheboygan County to support our elderly, disabled and homebound residents in need of nutritional support. The 3% number that has been mentioned in the news refers to the budget for Meals on Wheels America, a national advocacy organization for meals programs. It gets 3% of its funding from federal programs.

Approximately 30 percent of our clients get help paying for meals through the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC), Community Care, IRIS and other programs that depend on federal dollars. If funding is cut to those organizations, our clients are at risk of losing their meal benefits.

The generosity of our donors

has enabled us to operate without a wait list (unlike most Meals on Wheels programs) for over 45 years. We have always fed anyone who needs nutritional support, and with the community's support, we intend to continue regardless of what happens with the budget.

Funding MOW Saves Tax Dollars

Studies show that seniors who get home-delivered meals each day feel safer, less lonely and isolated, and have fewer falls and hospitalizations. They are able to stay in their homes and out of taxpayer-funded nursing homes. A Brown University study found that **\$1 spent on home-delivered meals for seniors, saves \$50 in taxpayer funded Medicare/Medicaid costs.**

Who We Serve

We serve elderly, disabled and homebound residents of Sheboygan County regardless of age or income. We currently serve 1,200 meals each week to 270 clients.

Our clients include veterans, former teachers, factory workers, and many others who contributed greatly to our community.
