X 7ith several growing seasons under our belt and garden spaces dedicated to Meals On Wheels popping up across Sheboygan County, we were able to grow nearly 6,000 pounds of produce for client meals in 2015. In addition to growing produce in 27 raised beds, creating edible landscaping and our on-site rhubarb garden, we grew potatoes in donated shopping carts at Wildwood Garden, raised a hoop house at Ebenezer UCC and helped a volunteer plant and harvest a large plot in Adell dedicated to Meals On Wheels.

Our partnership with Golden Bear Farm continued. In return for each pound of produce scrap we deliver, we receive a credit towards our next order.

Over 3,000 pounds of apples were donated to the program last fall, one of our

largest produce donations to date. Many of the apples were shined up and sent out whole, some were used in baking, and, as you can imagine, we made a lot of fresh applesauce. In total over 11,000 pounds of locally grown fruit and vegetables were donated to the program. We are thankful for each and every gift.

We're currently planning our gardens and edible landscaping for the 2016 growing season. If you are planning a garden, please Grow-a-Row for Meals On Wheels or consider donating your extra produce by dropping it off at our headquarters or at the Plymouth Chamber of Commerce.

eorge Quiriconi, the head chef at Christopher Farm & Gardens, has joined us each year during the winter months to help our culinary team prepare meals. A few weeks ago, George presented some of his recipes and shared his knowledge on canning honey with the Sheboygan County Beekeepers Association and interested folks from across the state.

This spring, we will be adding 60,000 bees to the Meals On Wheels family courtesy of Dan Pitsch. The bees will pollinate our gardens, increase produce yields and help keep our orchard's ecosystem healthy and our gardens thriving.

George's Cinnamon, Honey Applesauce

<u>Ingredients</u>

2 Tablespoons lemon juice

5-6 cups white sugar

I/4 cup brown sugar

3 Tablespoons honey

I/2 teaspoon salt

I-2 Tablespoons cinnamon

Cinnamon sticks: a half stick per pint or I per quart

5-6 pounds of apples (leave the skin on)

<u>Instructions</u>

Core and cut apples into quarters and place in a saucepan. Cover with water (up to 4 cups) and add 2 T of lemon juice or fruit-fresh powder to prevent browning.

Combine the rest of the ingredients and cook over medium heat until apples are soft (15 to 20 minutes).

After cooking use an immersion stick blender or other means to mix the applesauce. *If canning, follow the water bath method for 15 minutes.

ur longest meal delivery route is 40 miles, allowing fresh meals prepared in the Christopher Family Kitchen to be delivered to about 50 residents throughout Sheboygan County. Each delivery day, truck route volunteers load up five ovens (plugged in to keep warm) and five baskets (placed in the cooler to keep cold) onto the truck.

Over the next hour and a half, they make stops at Redeemer Lutheran Church in Plymouth, St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church in Elkhart Lake and National Exchange Bank in Howards Grove. From there additional volunteer drivers pick up meals for their individual route.

But that's not all, these volunteers diligently monitor the truck and let our volunteer coordinators know when it needs gas, an oil change or needs to be repaired. Indications from the volunteers allow us to keep this important piece of equipment properly maintained and in working order.

A dedicated group of about a dozen




While it's main function is to transport food, the truck is also used in parades and at special events.
