"It's so nice to do something that's different and meet so many nice people," says Charmaine.



Meals On Wheels

Don't let the summer heat get you down

Cases of heat-related illnesses soar with summer's high temperatures and thick, humid air, and older adults suffer from the heat in disproportionately large numbers. Experts note that as people age, their bodies don't adjust to temperature changes as easily, and they are more likely to have health issues or take medications that further upset the body's response to heat. The Centers for Disease Control suggest ways to stay cool this summer:

 Stay in air-conditioned buildings as much as possible. If you don't have air conditioning, contact the county health department or locate an air-conditioned shelter in your area.

 Don't rely on a fan as your main cooling source when it's really hot outside. Electric fans may provide comfort, but when the temperature is in the high 90s, they will not prevent heat-related illness.

- Take cool showers or baths to cool down.
- Drink more water than usual and don't wait until you're thirsty to drink. Note: If you have been told to limit your fluid intake, consult your doctor about how much to drink
- Avoid using the stove or oven to cook.
- Wear loose, lightweight, light-colored clothing.
- Avoid strenuous activities, and get plenty of rest. Check on a friend or neighbor and have

someone do the same for you. Fresh Meals On Wheels helps meal recipients keep
